WELCOME TO THE UNDER-5 PROGRAM

Dear U5 participants,

Welcome to the AYSO U5 Soccer program.

*The U5 players will meet as a group for 6 Saturdays, starting the first Saturday following Labor Day, at SoccerFest September 8, 2007. The first session will be at River View Sports Park on the Joan Kelly field (the field farthest to the west). We will hand out the t-shirts and socks that the kids will wear to each of the 6 sessions. Please come with a size 3 soccer ball and shin guards. Each **PLAYER MUST** wear shin guards in order to play (no exceptions). Tennis shoes are fine, cleats are optional. The first 30 minutes or so will be training, which includes the parents (that's you!) running drills with the kids. We will then split the kids up into teams to play 3 vs. 3 games, with 5 minute quarters. The girl's group photos will be at Noon and the boy's group photos will be at 12:10 p.m. Lunch will be available from the Lion's Club at the field for a minimal cost. The older AYSO players will be playing games at River View all day. It is a great day at the park, and we hope you will plan to stay.*

The schedule for the remaining 5 Saturdays (mid September through mid October) will be announced on Saturday 9/8, at the first session at SoccerFest.

For the 1st session at SoccerFest, please remember to bring SHIN GUARDS, a SIZE 3 SOCCER BALL, wear soft style soccer shorts. We will have t-shirts and socks for the kids.

For remaining 5 sessions the kids will need shin guards, a size 3 soccer ball, their soccer socks, t-shirts, and soft style soccer shorts (no pockets or zippers please). Sun block and water is always a good idea too.
